The program consists of three assignments of six months each and allows you to work on Bombardier's railway projects in Europe and possibly worldwide. The program includes three different tracks:

- The **PROFESSIONAL** track prepares graduates for specialist/expert roles within Bombardier Transportation, with a focus on products, technology and rail control solutions (RCS). Typical rotations are within **Engineering**, **Operations**, **Supply Chain**, **Procurement**, **Production Control**, **Project Management** and **Quality**.
- The GENERAL track has a more global focus with typical rotations in Business Development, Strategy, Bids & Sales, Innovation and Project Management.
- The **FUNCTIONAL** track includes rotations in one of the three functions: **Finance** (e.g. Group Finance, Controlling, Accounting & Reporting), **Human Resources** (e.g. Center of Expertise, Business Partnering, Shared Services Organization) or **IT/Information Services** (e.g. IS Infrastructure, Planning & Applications).
