General Course Information	
<b>Language of instruction</b>	<p>German and English</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In general, the language of instruction is German. Most study programmes offered at Ulm University are German-taught programmes. However, there may be select courses taught in English even in German study programmes. In addition, there are currently <a href="#">12 Master programmes taught completely in English</a>.</li> <li>Medicine and Dentistry are strictly taught in German (including exams or clinical electives).</li> <li>Students wishing to do a project or thesis in any of the other subject areas do not need to prove proficiency in German, as long as they have sufficient command of English.</li> </ul>
<b>Admission to Master level courses</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students should have successfully completed at least 3 years of study (approx. 180 ECTS)</li> <li>All students must meet the linguistic and academic requirements of any given course.</li> </ul>
<b>Courses from other departments and faculties</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students are expected to select the majority of courses and/or credits from the subject area corresponding to that at their home institution. They may choose up to two courses per semester from study programmes in other departments/faculties. Admission to courses in other departments/faculties can be restricted, giving priority to degree students and students coming over a direct agreement with that particular department.</li> <li>In addition, students may take courses from the School of Humanities (language courses, philosophy, soft skills).</li> <li>Courses from career-integrated programmes or the continuing professional education programmes offered by the School of Advanced Professional Studies (SAPS) are not open to exchange students.</li> </ul>

<b>Nomination</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Via <a href="#">Mobility Online</a></li> <li>• After nominations have been received and confirmed, students receive an e-mail with a link to the online application</li> </ul>
<b>Application documents</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recent Transcript of Records</li> <li>• Proposal of Courses</li> <li>• Certificate of Language Proficiency</li> <li>• Housing Application</li> <li>• Copy of Passport</li> </ul>
<b>Language requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We expect students to have <b>at least level B2 in the language of instruction / working language</b>.</li> <li>• If students wish to take classes in both English and German, <u>both</u> languages must be certified.</li> <li>• Students who have only level B1 in German at the time of application may be accepted under the condition that they participate in the <b>Intensive German Language Course</b> prior to the beginning of their studies (September/March)</li> <li>• Students wishing to do <b>practical work in a hospital</b> (elective/clerkship/rotation) must prove that they have min. level B2 in German at the time of application.</li> </ul>

<b>Intensive German Language Course</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Levels A1/A2/B1</li> <li>• In September (before the beginning of the winter semester)</li> <li>• In March (before the beginning of the summer semester)</li> <li>• 3 ECTS</li> </ul>
<b>Orientation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Upon arrival: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ welcome service &amp; administrative assistance</li> </ul> </li> <li>• In October / In April: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ City Tour / Library Tour / Welcome Day</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
