Information on data protection in accordance with Art. 13 GDPR on application and membership in the NEUROSCIENCE CENTER ULM (NCU)

The protection of your personal data is important to us, which is why we would like to inform you here about the purpose for which Ulm University (to which the NCU belongs) collects, stores or forwards your data. The information also tells you what rights you have with regard to your personal data.

1. Controller for data processing

2. Purpose of data processing

We process personal data in order to decide about your membership application for the NCU and to contact you within the framework of activities related to the NCU.

In case you gave your consent that your name and affiliation are mentioned on the homepage, we will present your information for the purpose of public outreach.

3. Categories of data

The following personal data of yours will be processed:

Contact data; study program and study progress data; data on professional position and employer

4. Legal basis for data processing

The legal basis for the processing is your consent, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a GDPR.

5. Storage of your data

We only store your personal data for as long as is necessary for the decision on your application and, with your consent, presentation on the homepage. In case you do not qualify to become a member of NCU, your application will be deleted at the latest 1 week after the decision, provided that deletion does not conflict with any other legitimate interests of the controller. When you become a member of NCU, your contact data will be stored for the duration of your membership.

6. Recipient of your data

Within the scope of decision making, NCU activities and public outreach your data will be used by the responsible employees within the Institutes of the current speakers and/or the Center for Research Strategy and Support. Only those persons within the university have access to your data who need it for the proper execution of the aforementioned purpose.

7. Your rights as a data subject

You have the following rights to protect your personal data:

- to obtain confirmation as to whether or not your personal data is or has been processed (Art. 15 GDPR)
- to obtain rectification of accurate personal data (Art. 16 GDPR),
- to obtain the erasure or restriction of the processing of your personal data under certain conditions (Art. 17, 18 GDPR)
- to object to the processing of your data (Art. 21 GDPR),
- to have your data transmitted to other bodies specified by you (Art. 20 GDPR). Separate consent is required for this.

You also have the right to contact the competent supervisory authority for data protection if you are of the opinion that the processing of your personal data is not lawful.
