Selection of Master's thesis topic

- Depending on individual interest, independent search for a suitable Master's thesis topic and corresponding working group/institute
- Contact with future Master's thesis supervisors is often established through participation in 15 LP Master modules
- Individual agreement on the start date of the advanced internship and the Master's thesis

Advanced methods course

- MSc Biochemistry: 'Fortgeschrittene Methoden der Biochemie' (9 SWS)
- MSc Biology: 'Advanced Methods in Biology' (practical course (10 SWS) plus seminar/participation in the institute seminar (2 SWS))
- Is usually already carried out at the lab of the supervisor of the master thesis (aim of the course: preparation for the master thesis)
- Duration: usually 5 weeks
- Ungraded certificate of achievement (can be completed with a presentation)
- \rightarrow is entered by the supervisor in the campusonline portal

Masterthesis I

- Prerequisite for admission to the Master thesis:
 - 1. min. acquired 60 LP in the Master
 - 2. advanced methods course has been successfully completed
- Registration in the student administration and examination office of the UUIm
- → Form: <u>https://www.uni-ulm.de/nawi/nawibiologie/studierende/abschlussarbeiten/</u>
- Will be reviewed by 2 reviewers

• IMPORTANT: Application for external work ≠ Registration

Masterthesis II

- Duration: 6 months (max. 4 weeks extension)
- Language: usually English → with the approval of the reviewers also possible in German
- Add the declaration according to § 18 (8) of <u>"Rahmenordnung"</u> to your Master's thesis
- Submission: in due time in electronic form to the student administration and examination office (by e-mail or as an uploaded file, <u>https://www.uni-</u>



Masterthesis III

 If submitted at the beginning of a new semester: without reregistration, submission of the Master thesis is possible up to 1 month after the start of lectures → new semester does not count into the number of semesters in the course of study
