



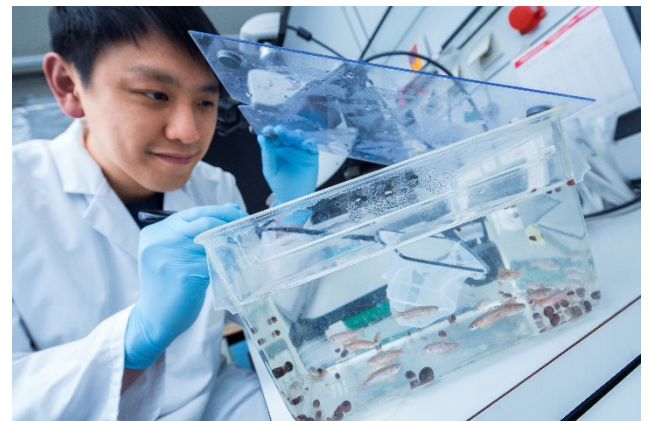
The lab of Gilbert Weidinger at the Institute of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology is looking for a

Our lab works on the mechanisms of innate regeneration. www.uni-ulm.de/weidinger.

We use zebrafish (*Danio rerio*) as model organism. We maintain a large fish colony and raise new generations ourselves. You would be responsible for feeding the fish and larvae and for cleaning aquaria. In addition to ensuring the well-being of our fish, you would gain important insight into husbandry and handling of one of the most important vertebrate models for biomedical research.



We are looking for reliable individuals with the ability to work self-sufficiently and efficiently.

Working hours:

- Twice a week on a weekday between 7:30 and 11:00 for 1 to 1.5 hours
- Once every 2-3 weeks on Friday afternoon between 16:00 and 20:00 for 2 hours
- Once a month on Saturday or Sunday for 4.5 hours
- Rest of the working time is flexible

Preference is given to applicants who can commit to performing the job for at least two semesters, including the university holidays ("vorlesungsfreie Zeiten").
