Import akx Files into SciFinder (old)

When answer sets are no more saved in **SciFinder** (old) and exist only in form of .akx files, they must first be imported into **SciFinder** (old) before migrating the to **SciFinder**ⁿ. A direct import of .akx files into **SciFinder**ⁿ is not possible.

Sign in to **SciFinder** (old). Click on "Import" in the text box named "SAVED ANSWER SETS" on the right side.
