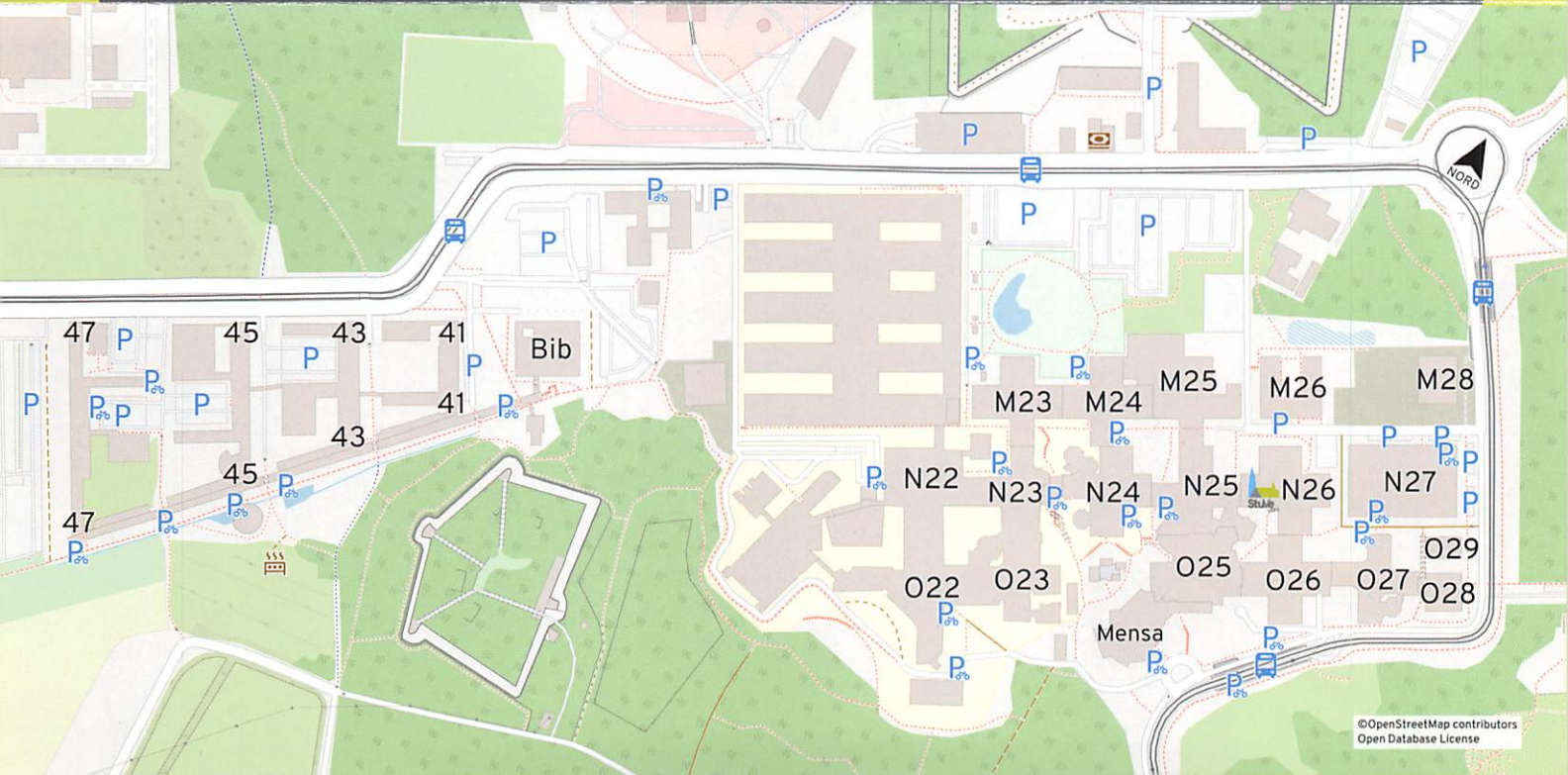

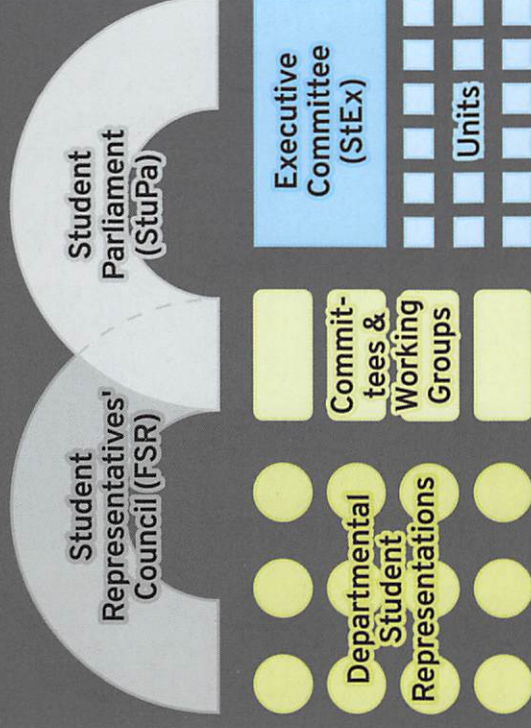

Next to the Departmental Student Representations, which engage for you in your field of studies, there is also the **Student Representation** (short StuVe) for university wide affairs and the communication with the university and other organisations.



The Student Representation consists of various committees and bodies which stand up for the affairs of all students (e.g. improving the teaching). The legislative bodies, the Student Parliament and the Student Representatives' Council, are once a year elected by all students and meet in public. The Executive Committee and the units are the executive bodies. Beyond that many students contribute to working groups and specific committees.
